**AMENDED AND RESTATED BYLAWS
of
THE PRESSER FOUNDATION
a Pennsylvania Nonprofit Corporation**

(Adopted June 2022)

1. CORPORATION

1.1. Name.

The name of this corporation is The Presser Foundation (the “**Foundation**”).

1.2. Offices; Place of Business.

The registered office and principal place of business of the Foundation shall be located in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. The Foundation may have any number of other offices or other places of business at such places as the Board of Trustees of the Foundation (each a “**Trustee**” or, collectively, the “**Board**”) may from time to time determine.

1.3. Purposes.

The “**Purposes**” of the Foundation are exclusively charitable, as set forth in the Articles of Incorporation of the Foundation, as amended (the “**Articles**”).

1.4. Fiscal Year.

The fiscal year of the Foundation shall begin on the first day of July and end on the last day of June, or as otherwise determined by the Board.

2. BOARD OF TRUSTEES

The business and affairs of the Foundation shall be managed by the Board. In addition to the powers and authority expressly granted by these Bylaws, the Board may exercise all powers of the Foundation and do all acts that are not prohibited by applicable law, the Articles, or these Bylaws.

2.1. Number and Qualifications.

The Board shall consist of not fewer than nine (9) nor more than twenty-one (21) Trustees, or such number as determined by the Board, who shall each be an individual person of no less than 18 years of age.



2.2. Term and Election.

Trustees shall be chosen by the Board at the Annual Meeting and shall serve for terms of three (3) years and until their successors are duly elected. As nearly as possible, an equal number of Trustees shall be elected into three (3) classes with terms expiring in consecutive years. The Nominating & Governance Committee of the Foundation may provide the Board with a slate of recommended successor Trustees (the “**Trustee Slate**”) prior to the Annual Meeting. The Board shall consider the Trustee Slate but shall not be bound to elect any particular successor Trustee(s) proposed on the Trustee Slate, and the Board may adjust the Trustee Slate.

2.3. Subsequent Terms.

A Trustee may be elected by the Board to serve unlimited subsequent three (3)-year terms, provided that the Nominating & Governance Committee of the Foundation determines that such Trustee continues to be a fully engaged, contributing member of the Board and such Trustee has not reached eighty (80) years of age at the time of such Trustee’s subsequent election.

2.4. Vacancies.

Vacancies in any Trustee position shall be filled by the Board. Each such election shall be for the unexpired term.

2.5. Annual and Regular Meetings.

An annual meeting of the Board for, among other things, the election of Trustees and Officers, shall be held once each calendar year, generally on a day toward the end of the fiscal year (the “**Annual Meeting**”). In addition to the Annual Meeting, other regular meetings of the Board shall be held at such times and at such places, within or outside the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, as the Board may from time to time determine and not less than two (2) times in each calendar year. Notice of the Annual Meeting and each regular meeting shall be provided to the Board at least five (5) days prior to such meeting, provided that the Board may determine to provide a schedule of such meetings (a “**Schedule**”), and the provision of the Schedule once a year shall be sufficient notice of such meetings.

2.6. Special Meetings of the Board.

The President or twenty percent (20%) of the Board may cause the Secretary to call a special meeting of the Board. At least five (5) days’ Notice stating the time, place, and purpose of any special meeting shall be given to the members of the Board.



2.7. Quorum.

A majority of the Board shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of all business at any meeting of the Board. If a quorum shall not be present at any meeting of the Board, the Trustees present thereat may adjourn the meeting, without notice, other than an announcement at the meeting, until a quorum shall be present.

2.8. Vote and Actions by the Board.

Each Trustee shall be entitled to one (1) vote. The acts of a majority of the Trustees present at a meeting at which a quorum is present shall be the acts of the Board, except as may be otherwise specifically provided by statute or by these Bylaws.

2.9. Executive Session

The Board may go into an “**Executive Session**” where all, or any combination, of any identified guests, staff, or other persons without a vote as a Trustee, including the Executive Director, are asked to leave the meeting for the discussion, or any part thereof, and vote.

2.10. Grant Approval.

The Board shall approve or accept the reports and recommendations of the Foundation’s committees and officers, as appropriate, at its regular and special meetings, and shall have the responsibility of approving all grants and awards of the Foundation. No grant or award may be made by the Foundation without an act of the Board.

2.11. Periodic Review.

The Board shall periodically review the operations and activities of the Foundation to ensure that the Board is best fulfilling the purposes set forth by Theodore Presser in the various founding documents of the Foundation and Trust in light of current conditions and needs. As it deems desirable, the Board may discontinue grant programs or add grant programs or alter the goals and requirements of existing grant programs as best serves the Purposes.

2.12. Audit and Financial Statements.

The Board shall consider and approve an audited statement of revenue, expense, assets, and liabilities of the Foundation for the fiscal year just ended prepared by a certified public accountant in accordance with applicable accounting standards. It shall also approve a budget of revenue and expense in advance of the new fiscal year, generally at the Annual Meeting.



2.13. Remuneration.

Trustees shall receive no pay, fee, or compensation for their service on the Board. Nothing herein contained shall be construed to preclude any Trustee from receiving reimbursement for reasonable expenses incurred in the performance of his or her duties as a Trustee, or reasonable compensation for other services to the Foundation, subject to the terms of the Foundation's Conflicts of Interest Policy and applicable law.

2.14. Honorary Trustees.

The Board shall have the power to elect honorary trustees to serve as advisors and ambassadors to the Foundation ("**Honorary Trustees**") at the Annual Meeting or as the Board determines. The Nominating & Governance Committee of the Foundation may provide the Board with a slate of recommended Honorary Trustees, if any, included on the Trustee Slate prior to the Annual Meeting. The Board shall consider the Trustee Slate but shall not be bound to elect any particular Honorary Trustee(s) proposed on the Trustee Slate, and the Board may adjust the Trustee Slate. The Honorary Trustee designation is bestowed upon those whose continued guidance and advice is valued and welcomed by the Board. Honorary Trustees may serve on committees of the Foundation and attend the Annual Meeting. Each Honorary Trustee shall not have voting privileges regarding the activities of the Foundation and shall not be deemed to be a Trustee or a fiduciary of the Foundation for the purposes of Pennsylvania law or any other state or federal law, nor shall Honorary Trustees have any of the duties or obligations of a director under Pennsylvania law or any other state or federal law, solely by virtue of their role as an Honorary Trustee. If the Board shall enter Executive Session, Honorary Trustees shall leave the room and abstain from the remaining discussion and all participation in Executive Session matters. Each Honorary Trustee shall serve for an unlimited term or until such Honorary Trustee resigns or is removed pursuant to these Bylaws.

2.15. Resignations.

A Trustee or Honorary Trustee may resign at any time by giving written notice to the President of the Foundation (each, a "**Resignation Notice**"), with copy of the Resignation Notice given to the Executive Director of the Foundation, if any. Such resignation shall be effective on the date that the Foundation receives the Resignation Notice from the resigning Trustee or Honorary Trustee, or at a subsequent date as may be specified in the Resignation Notice.

3. OFFICERS

3.1. Election and Term.

The officers of the Foundation shall consist of a President, Vice President, Treasurer, Secretary, and those additional officers, if any, that the Board may from time to time deem necessary for the proper conduct of the affairs of the Foundation (each, an "**Officer**"). Officers shall be chosen from among the Trustees by the Board at the Annual Meeting and shall serve for terms of one (1) year and until



their successors are duly elected. The Nominating & Governance Committee of the Foundation may provide the Board with a slate of recommended successor Officers (the “**Officer Slate**”). The Board shall consider the Officer Slate but shall not be bound to elect any particular successor Officer proposed on the Officer Slate, and the Board may adjust the Officer Slate.

3.2. Vacancies.

Officer vacancies shall be filled by a vote of the Board. Each such election shall be for the unexpired term. The Board may add a new Officer with such person to serve until the next Annual Meeting.

3.3. President.

The President shall preside at all meetings of the Board and shall have executive direction of the activities of the Foundation. The President shall appoint all committee members and committee chairs, except when otherwise provided for by the Board. The President shall be an *ex officio* non-voting member of all committees. The President may engage paid staff or consultants to assist in the administration of the work of the Foundation, provided that each such expense is included within a budget approved by the Board.

3.4. Vice President.

The Vice President shall preside at any meeting of the Board that the President is unable to attend and shall have executive direction of the activities of the Foundation in the absence or incapacitation of the President. The Vice President shall serve as acting President if the office of the President falls vacant for any reason until a successor President is elected.

3.5. Treasurer.

The Treasurer shall keep and maintain, or cause to be kept and maintained, adequate and correct accounts of the revenue, expense, assets, and liabilities of the Foundation as required by applicable state and federal law and prevailing nonprofit corporation accounting standards. The Treasurer shall be an *ex-officio* voting member of the Finance Committee. The Treasurer shall carry out, or cause to be carried out by the Finance Committee Chair, staff or consultants retained by the Foundation for such purpose, the Finance Committee’s directions for the investment of the Foundation’s assets. Working with the Finance Committee and the President, the Treasurer shall determine the annual required distribution of the Foundation’s assets to comply with federal law and will assist the President in formulating the annual budget of the Foundation for presentation and approval by the Finance Committee and the Board.

3.6. Secretary.

The Secretary shall record the minutes of the proceedings of the Board and arrange for the proper execution of all necessary documents as may be required by applicable state and federal laws.



3.7. Executive Director

An Executive Director may be appointed by the Board. The Executive Director, if any, shall be accountable to the Board and subject to the direction of the President and shall perform the duties and functions as may be prescribed from time to time by the Board. The Executive Director, if any, shall be an *ex officio* non-voting member of the Board and an *ex officio* non-voting member of all committees, provided that the Board or the Executive Committee may ask the Executive Director to leave the room or abstain from the remaining discussion and all participation during an Executive Session.

3.8 Resignations.

An Officer of the Foundation may resign at any time by a Resignation Notice to the President of the Foundation, with copy of the Resignation Notice given to the Executive Director of the Foundation, if any. Such resignation shall be effective on the date that the Foundation receives the Resignation Notice from the resigning Officer, or at a subsequent date as may be specified in the Resignation Notice. In the case of the President, the Resignation Notice shall be given to the Secretary of the Foundation, with copy of the Resignation Notice given to the Executive Director of the Foundation, if any.

4. COMMITTEES

4.1. Standing Committees.

The Foundation shall have at least the following four (4) standing committees:

4.1.1. Executive Committee.

The Executive Committee shall consist of the Officers and shall be chaired by the President, which committee shall exercise the authority of the Board in the management of the Foundation in urgent circumstances when immediate action is required that, in the judgment of the President, cannot prudently wait for the next scheduled Board meeting. Any actions of the Executive Committee shall be presented in full at the subsequent Board meeting.

4.1.2. Finance Committee.

The Board shall have the power to appoint the members of the Finance Committee at the Annual Meeting or as the Board determines. The Nominating & Governance Committee of the Foundation may provide the Board with a slate of recommended successor members of the Finance Committee (the "**Finance Committee Slate**") prior to the Annual Meeting. The Board shall consider the Finance Committee Slate but shall not be bound to elect any particular successor members proposed on the Finance Committee Slate, and the Board may adjust the Finance Committee Slate. The Finance Committee's chair shall be a Trustee (who may but need not be the Treasurer). The Finance



Committee shall periodically review the investments of the Foundation, formulate an appropriate Investment Policy for the Foundation, direct the investment of the Foundation's assets, and retain and hire such outside investment advisors as it deems appropriate, subject to the approval the Board. It shall also consider, review, and recommend for consideration by the Board the annual operating budget of the Foundation.

4.1.3. Nominating & Governance Committee

The Nominating & Governance Committee shall be charged with developing the Trustee Slate, the Officer Slate, and the Finance Committee Slate, which may include recommendations to be voted on at the Annual Meeting as well as potential additional Trustees, Officers, and members of the Finance Committee who may be nominated during the course of the year, and a list of persons to consider for other committee roles. In developing the Officer Slate, Officers shall be drawn from among the Trustees. The Nominating & Governance Committee shall periodically review and propose revisions to these Bylaws and see that other compliance-related documents, such as the Conflict of Interest Policy, are distributed and acted on as required. Additionally, the Nominating & Governance Committee shall be charged with periodically reviewing the mission, programs, and operation of the Foundation to see that they are most effectively carrying out the Purposes and are aligned with the needs of the field of music education and performance.

4.1.4. Diversity, Equity, & Inclusion Committee

The Diversity, Equity, & Inclusion (DEI) Committee shall be charged with promoting the Foundation's diversity, equity, and inclusion activities. It shall advise and work with the Board and the Committees of the Foundation as appropriate from time to time to develop and carry out the Foundation's diversity, equity and inclusion platform. Additionally, the DEI Committee shall be charged with periodically reviewing, reporting and analyzing the Foundation's efforts and progress. The DEI Committee shall consist of 7 members, of which up to 3 may be non-Trustees.

4.2. Other Committees; Restrictions on Authority.

The Board may designate additional committees, including one or several grantmaking committees. Except as otherwise provided herein or by the Board, the President shall appoint the members and chair of any such committee, and the President or the chair of any committee may remove any member of such a committee whenever in their judgment the best interests of the Foundation shall be served by such removal. No committee of the Foundation may: create or fill vacancies in the Board; adopt, amend, or repeal any portion of the Bylaws; amend or repeal of any resolution of the Board that by its terms is amendable or repealable only by the Board; or act on matters committed by these Bylaws or a resolution of the Board exclusively to another committee of the Foundation.



4.2.1. Grantmaking Committees

Each grantmaking committee, if any, shall develop guidelines and criteria for the various grant programs of the Foundation. Grantmaking Committees may include, but are not limited to, the following: Advancement of Music, Special Projects, Capital Support, Scholar Awards, and Assistance to Music Teachers.

5. CONFLICTS OF INTEREST

5.1. Conflict of Interest Policy.

The Foundation shall implement and abide by a Conflict of Interest Policy, which policy shall apply to each person holding a position of responsibility or trust on behalf of the Foundation.

6. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY AND INDEMNIFICATION

6.1. Limitation of Liability.

Trustees of the Foundation shall not be personally liable for monetary damages for any action taken or failure to take any action other than as expressly provided in Pennsylvania law. It is the intention of these Bylaws to limit the liability of Trustees to the fullest extent permitted by any present or future provision of Pennsylvania law.

6.2. Indemnification.

The Foundation shall hold harmless, defend, and indemnify Trustees, committee members, and Officers and may by a resolution of the Board hold harmless, defend, and indemnify other employees and agents, including volunteers, of the Foundation when acting on behalf of the Foundation to the fullest extent permitted by any applicable provisions of Pennsylvania and federal law. The Foundation may procure insurance providing greater indemnification to those people and may share the premium cost with any of those people.

6.3. Advancing Expenses.

Expenses incurred by a person entitled to be indemnified under these Bylaws shall be paid by the Foundation in advance of the final disposition of any action, suit, or proceeding upon receipt of: (a) a written affirmation by the person of his or her good faith belief that he or she has met the relevant standard of conduct required by any applicable provision of Pennsylvania or federal law; and (b) a written undertaking by or on behalf of such person to repay such amount if it shall ultimately be determined by a court of competent jurisdiction that he or she is not entitled to be indemnified by the Foundation.



6.4. Proceedings Initiated by Person Entitled to be Indemnified.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these Bylaws, the Foundation shall not indemnify any individual for any liability incurred in a proceeding initiated or participated in as an intervenor or amicus curiae by the person seeking indemnification unless such initiation of or participation in the proceeding is authorized, either before or after its commencement, by a resolution of the Board adopted by the affirmative vote of a majority of the Trustees excluding any Trustees seeking indemnification, unless such proceeding was brought to enforce such officer's or Trustee's rights to indemnification or advancement of expenses under these Bylaws in accordance with the provisions set forth herein.

6.5. Rights to Indemnification.

Any rights to indemnification provided by these Bylaws are not exclusive and do not exclude other rights of the indemnified individual. Any amendment or modification of these Bylaws providing for indemnification pursuant to these Bylaws that has the effect of limiting a person's rights to indemnification with respect to any act or failure to act occurring prior to the date of adoption of such amendment or modification shall not be effective as to that person unless he or she consents in writing to be bound by such amendment or modification. The rights provided by or granted pursuant to this Section to a person shall inure to the benefit of his or her heirs, executors, and administrators.

7. REMOVAL FROM OFFICE.

Any Trustee, Officer, or Honorary Trustee may be removed from office, with or without cause, by a vote of two-thirds of all Trustees then serving on the Board. Such action shall be taken at a regular meeting of the Board or at a special meeting called for such purpose, provided that the proposed removal shall be set forth in the Notice of any special meeting.

8. RESTRICTIONS

Notwithstanding any other provision of the Articles or any provision contained herein, the powers and activities of the Foundation shall be subject to the following restrictions and limitations that could trigger an excise tax under the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "**Code**"). The Foundation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be conducted or carried on by an organization exempt under Section 501(a) of the Code and described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Code, or by an organization described under Section 170(c)(2) of the Code, contributions to which are deductible under Sections 170(a), 2055(a)(2), and 2522(a)(2) of the Code, nor shall the Foundation engage in any year in which it may be a "private foundation," as defined in Section 509 of the Code, in any act prohibited by Section 4941(d) or 4943(c) of the Code, or do any act, or fail to do any acts, that will result in the imposition of tax on the Foundation under Sections 4942, 4944, or 4945 of the Code, including:



- A. carrying on propaganda, or otherwise to attempt, to influence legislation (within the meaning of Section 4945(d)(1) of the Code);
- B. influencing the outcome of any specific public election, or to carry on, directly or indirectly, any voter registration drive (within the meaning of Section 4945(d)(2) of the Code);
- C. making any grant that does not comply with the requirements of Section 4945(d)(3) (regarding grants to individuals) or 4945(d)(4) (regarding grants to organizations) of the Code; or
- D. undertaking any activity for any purpose other than the Purposes or another purpose specified in Section 170(c)(2)(B) in the Code.

9. NOTICE AND PROCEDURES.

9.1. Notice.

For the purposes of these Bylaws, “**Notice**” shall include notice delivered by regular post, private delivery, through shared electronic document sites that the Trustees have access to, by facsimile transmission, through electronic mail to the Trustees, or through any other appropriate media that creates a record of transmission for verification purposes. The Secretary or Executive Director, if any, shall maintain a directory containing the email address of record for each Trustee for purposes of Notice. When sent on behalf of the Foundation, such Notice shall be deemed given as of the date shown as “sent” in the electronic mail account of the sender; when sent to the Foundation, such Notice shall be deemed given as of the date received in the electronic mail account of the Foundation or its Trustee, Officer, or agent. Each Trustee may update their email address of record by providing Notice of such change to the Secretary or Executive Director, if any.

9.2. Waiver of Notice.

Whenever any Notice is required to be given under applicable Pennsylvania law, or under the provisions of the Articles or these Bylaws, a waiver thereof in writing signed by the person or persons entitled to receive such Notice, whether before or after the time stated therein, shall be deemed equivalent to the giving of such Notice.

9.3. Action by Written Consent.

Any action which may be taken at a meeting of the Board, or any committee of the Foundation, may be taken without a meeting if a consent or consents in writing setting forth the action so taken shall be signed by all of the Trustees in office, or of all of the members of such committee, and shall be filed with the Secretary.

9.4. Use of Conference Telephone and Similar Equipment

To the fullest extent permitted by Pennsylvania law, one or more persons may participate in a meeting of the Board, any committee of the Foundation, by means of conference telephone, video conferencing, or similar communications equipment by means of which all persons participating in



such meeting can hear each other and participate fully. Participation in such meeting pursuant to this Section shall constitute presence in person at such meeting.

10. AMENDMENTS TO BYLAWS

These Bylaws may be amended by the Board at any regular or special meeting of the Board, provided that a general description of the proposed amendment shall be set forth in the Notice of any special meeting.
